FIJI GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE TO STUDENTS AFFECTED BY THE EARTHQUAKE AND TSUNAMI FROM TOHOKU REGION OF JAPAN

The Fiji Government as part of its humanitarian assistance to the people of Japan and those affected by the 11 March 2011 earthquake and tsunami in the prefectures of Fukushima, Iwate and Miyagi of Japan has decided to offer 20 scholarships to students directly affected by the disaster. The scholarship is for 10 university students at undergraduate level to study at the Fiji National University [FNU] for 1 year and 10 high school students to study at high school in Fiji for 1 year also.

Under the terms of the scholarship the Fiji Government will cover the following costs to the students selected:

For **all the 20 students** selected: Government will cover air travel costs to Fiji and back to Japan at the end of the 1 year.

For the 10 High School Students the following will be provided by the Fiji Government.

- Tuition fees for 1 year;
- Boarding Fees if needed or home stay;
- Meals – 3 per day;
- Stationaries and school supplies;
- Uniforms;
- Text books;
- Pocket allowance.

For the 10 university undergraduate students, **they must** be able to study in the following programmes at the FNU: Business, Hospitality, Humanities, Education, Engineering, Agriculture, Forestry, Fisheries, Dentistry, Health Sciences, Nursing and Public Health. The scholarship for the university students covers tuition, accommodation at Hostel as well.
